The vessel is restricted to the waters of Puerto Rico, not more than three (3) nautical miles from land and shall not operate more than twenty (20) nautical miles from a Harbor of Safe Refuge. The following ports are designated as Harbors of Safe Refuge: Arecibo, San Juan, Culebra (Bahia Sardinias), Vieques (Isabel Segunda), Fajardo, Humacao, Yabucoa, Salinas, Ponce, Guanica, Lajas (La Parguera), Guayanilla, and Mayaguez.

The master, and licensed mate if required, must have an auxiliary sail endorsement on their license.

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Vessel Name: EAST WIND

The vessel is not approved for operation in exposed waters, while operating in partially protected waters, the number of passengers is eighty (80) and total persons allowed is eighty-five (85).

If the vessel is away from the dock, or passengers are onboard or have access to the vessel, for a period exceeding twelve (12) hours in a twenty-four (24) hour period, an alternate crew shall be provided.

The minimum number of child-size life preservers is nine (9). When more than nine (9) persons weighing less than ninety (90) pounds are carried, additional child-size life preservers shall be carried so that the vessel has an approved life preserver suitable for each such person onboard.

A minimum freeboard of 5 feet 0-1/8 inches to the main deck at midship must be maintained. Maximum significant wave height: eight (8) feet. Maximum design speed: ten (10) knots. Maximum running trim at design speed: one (1) degree.

The master shall not act as snorkel guide master and must remain onboard the vessel for the entire voyage from the time passengers are embarked until they are disembarked at the final destination. The required deckhand may serve as snorkel guide only when the vessel is securely moored.

The sails which may be set are limited to those shown on the approved sail plan, bearing the U.S. Coast Guard Marine Safety Center approval stamp dated 29 December 1999. The plan must be maintained onboard the vessel, in a suitable location, at all times.

Passengers shall not be carried on the forward netting while the vessel is underway.
