When operating on exposed waters or partially protected waters, the sails which may be set are limited to the mainsail and jib, as shown on the vessel's sail plan, bearing the U.S. Coast Guard Marine Safety Center approval stamp dated 26JUN09. The plan must be maintained onboard the vessel, in a suitable location, at all times.

When operating on protected waters, the sails which may be set are limited to the mainsail, jib, and screecher, as shown on the vessel's sail plan mentioned above.
