The master may not act as snorkel guide and must remain on board the vessel for the entire voyage from the time passengers are embarked until they are disembarked at the final destination.

The minimum number of child-size life preservers is thirteen (13). When more than thirteen (13) persons weighing less than ninety (90) pounds are carried, additional child-size life preservers shall be carried so that the vessel has an approved life preserver suitable for each such person onboard.

A maximum of thirty four (34) passengers may be carried on the uppermost passenger deck.

While the vessel is underway, passengers located in the aft passenger deck area must remain in the seating area due to the absence of rails at the periphery of the vessel.
